

Making Africa more Resilient

Climate-Proofing Africa starts with TAHMO data together with that of National Meteorological and Hydrological Services.



The idea behind the TAHMO initiative is to develop a dense network of hydro-meteorological monitoring stations in sub-Saharan Africa – one every 30 km. This entails the installation of 20,000 stations across the continent.

GET TO KNOW HOW WE WORK

TAHMO always works under agreement of national or regional governments. Typically, a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the National Meteorological Agency defines the modus operandi in a country. It is also possible that, in case of externally funded projects, TAHMO has agreements with other government agencies or NGOs that have agreements with the local governments.
